

Terms of Appointment

- SMASH trustees are appointed for a term of 3 years. Trustees can be reappointed for up to 3 terms, until they have served a maximum of 9 years.
- Trustees attend approximately 10 meetings a year, including our AGM.
 We meet in person at roughly 4 of these, with the rest being online.
- SMASH has a Code of Conduct for all staff and volunteers, including trustees which all must abide by.
- Trustees will need to declare any conflict of interests when becoming a trustee, a record of which is reviewed annually.
- SMASH trustees should aim for full attendance at board meetings, unless there are exceptional circumstances.
